

Vanquish Pro Ant Bait is a new generation Ant Bait developed, tested and made in NZ. Vanquish Pro has both protein and carbohydrate in the matrix to attract a wider variety of ants.

Vanquish Pro has Fipronil as its active ingredient, at very low levels (0.01%), so that the bait will find its way right back into the nest where it will do most of the damage to the colony. Eradication depends on the whole colony being treated at once.

Vanquish Pro also retains its moisture levels for longer, allowing longer feeding time on the bait once placed in their habitat

Label directions must be followed on the label to get maximum effectiveness from Vanquish Pro.

How to lay Vanquish Pro Ant Bait

- Check with neighbours. If they have a bad ant infestation too, properties should be baited on the same day for maximum effect. If possible, plan baiting to coincide with high levels of ant activity, for example mid-summer or on fine warm days. Vanquish Pro will work all year round.
- Use a caulking gun to squeeze out the paste. Lay bait in small 'blobs' similar to the amount of toothpaste you would put on your toothbrush. A 325 gram tube should cover 1100m² of flat land, (assuming a medium ant density). Maximum application is one 325 gram tube per 550m².
- Squeeze bait out onto the ground in a grid pattern at regular intervals of 1m to 2m. In bark gardens, the spacing should reduce to 1m x 1m, but in open grass areas, it can increase to 2m 3m.
- Target cracks and crevices where problem ants have been seen. Baits can actually help identify where the nests are sited. Follow the trail from the bait to find the nest. Put baits as close to the nests as possible.
- If you see heavy trails of ants going up trees, apply bait at the base and along branches.
- Put bait in shady places to help prevent drying out (tip: cover it with a large leaf). Placing the bait in hose pipe or irrigation tube will help prevent the bait from drying out and stop animals eating the bait.
- Keep other animals away from treatment area for at least four hours. While no harm will come to them if they eat it, you will have to re-bait.
- Do not lay bait inside buildings, as the bait will draw all ants inside.
- **NOTE:** Vanquish Pro Ant Bait is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. Do not lay within three metres of ponds, streams and storm-water channels.
- To achieve best results and to avoid any possibility of bait shyness, the entire area needing treatment must be baited in one single application. Any opened bait remaining must be refrigerated for a maximum of 2-3 days before being used.
- Re-baiting may be needed about 6-8 weeks later to kill any survivors/subsequently hatched ants. Watch for pockets that might have been very heavily infested as these may need to be re-treated.

Packaging

Available in vacuum packed 100g and 325g. The 325g cartridges must be dispensed through a caulking gun available from hardware shops.

1x 325g cartridges will treat 1100 sq m
